Adaptive Junior 1x Open and Women, to be raced side by side over 1000m fee £30

Format

- Time Trials over 1900m in all events except adaptive
- The fastest 6 in each Time Trial will proceed to the A final and then additional finals proportionate to the size of the entry and time available will be run.
- This event is raced over 2000m and is for experienced crews, it is not a suitable event for crews at their first regatta. Entries with very low CRI will not be accepted.

Rules

- Run under BR rules of racing.
- Course distance (except Adaptive 1x) 2000m, Time Trials held over 1900m
- Gold Silver and bronze medals cast especially for the regatta for all events
- No composite crews
- All athletes must scull for the club where they carry out their normal day to day training and all those registered with BIRO must scull for their nominated club.
- No doubling up.
- No more than 50% of Crew may be J13.
- No J12's or younger competitors.
- Any doubts about eligibility please contact Entry Secretary .

Entries

- Entries and Payment via BROE2 only, Cheques will not be accepted.
- Opening 31st March Closing Friday 15th April at Noon.
- We will not suspend entries until the closing date so no need to rush.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if a crew withdraws after the closing date but BROE2 will remain open for substitutions.
- If an event is oversubscribed all clubs or schools will get one entry in the event (subject to their experience being adequate) then entries with the highest CRI will be selected.
- In the event of cancellation, a proportion of the entry fee may be returned
