Adaptive Junior 1x Open and Women, to be raced side by side over 1000m fee £24

Format

- Time Trials over 1900m in all events (except adaptive)
- The fastest 6 in each Time Trial will proceed to the A final. Additional finals proportionate to the entry and time available will be run. Finals over 2000m (except adaptive)
- This event is for experienced scullers only.

Rules

- Run under BR rules of racing.
- Gold medals where there are 3 entries, Gold and Silver where there are 4 entries, Gold, silver and Bronze where there are 5 or more entries.
- No composite crews, No doubling up.
- All athletes must scull for the club where they carry out their normal day to day training and all those registered with BIRO must scull for their nominated club.
- No more than 50% of Crew may be J13. No J12's or younger competitors.
- Any doubts about eligibility please contact Entry Secretary .

Entries

- Entries and Payment via BROE2 only.
- Opening 2nd April. Close Saturday 18th April at Noon.
- We will not suspend entries until the closing date so no need to rush.
- We expect to have more entries than we can fit into the day. All clubs or schools will get one entry in each event subject to achieving a minimum average PRI – average PRI is the average BROE Points per competitor. As a guideline, in 2025 A crews with average PRI above the following were accepted – J14 with 8 pts, J15 with 25 pts, J16 with 40 pts, J17/18s 50 pts.
- The best 2nd boat entries, ie with the highest PRI will be accepted. In 2025 we accepted 2nd boats with PRI above the following- J14 32pts, J15 100pts, J16 160pts J17/18 200pts. We will define the 2nd boats as those with the lower PRI for that club or school in each event, regardless of how the club and school designate them.
- The limits may increase or decrease depending on the number/quality of entries.
- If you enter a crew with a low average PRI but think they merit inclusion please email the entries secretary with justification and we'll consider this.
- No more than two entries from any club in one event.
- We will advise rejected crews on 22nd April to give you a chance to enter other events.
- We may merge or cancel events that have few entries.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if a crew withdraws after the closing date.
- In the event of cancellation, a proportion of the entry fee may be returned.
